Obligations during a game

Parents/supporters should

- 1) Applaud the opposition as well as your own team.
- 2) Avoid coaching the child during the game.
- 3) Refrain from shouting and screaming.
- 4) Respect the referee's decision
- 4) Give attention to each of the children involved in football, not just the most talented.
- 5) Give encouragement to everyone to participate in football.
- 6) Not to use inappropriate language
